KidZone will:

KidZone is OFSTED inspected and a copy of the report is available on request.

You and Your Child's Responsibility:

The staff at KidZone are dedicated to your child's well-being. In turn we encourage the children to be polite and show care, consideration and respect to the staff and to each other. If a behavioural problem occurs, you will be contacted to discuss a resolution. If the behaviour persists it may be necessary to exclude your child.

What and who are we?

The aim of the Club is to provide children with an enjoyable, safe and homely environment where they can be looked after before and after school. KidZone is a facility for the children from Stamfordham Village First School, Stampers Pre-School¹ and the surrounding middle schools. Other local children and children visiting the area can sometimes be accommodated. KidZone was established in October 2000 and is a charitable organisation (1082969). The Club is managed by a committee of parent volunteers. Staff/child ratios meet the required OFSTED guidelines.



Activities

The KidZone day begins with Breakfast Club² which is from 8am to 8.50am. Stamfordham Village First School is a healthy eating school and KidZone also follows the school healthy eating policy. We generally have a selection of fruit, cereals and wholemeal toast on sale. After breakfast the children are encouraged to read or play board games and socialise with friends and generally prepare for the day ahead.



After the school day ends, after 3.10pm, the children are collected from their classrooms and taken to the KidZone area and registration is completed by the staff. Children are encouraged to talk about their day, are given a drink, take time to relax and are welcome to bring along a snack to enjoy at the same time.

KidZone aims to provide a broad range of activities for the children to enjoy including board games, arts and crafts, pretend and imaginative play, reading, TV and DVDs, computer games and energetic outside games. There is also the chance to catch up with homework.



Terms and Conditions

KidZone requires a Registration Consent Form for each child providing all the necessary contact details, medical information and permissions. Each child pays an annual £15 registration fee (£20 for two children and £25 for three or more children). This fee is used to cover KidZone's overheads e.g. insurance, OFSTED registration fee. Once this form is completed, you and your child are encouraged to attend KidZone prior to your child's first session to get to know the staff and the other children.

Breakfast Club is open from 8am to 8.45am on school days. The After School Club is open from 3.10pm to 5.30pm³ and from 8.30am to 5pm in school holidays⁴.

Up to 4 hours £12

Bills will be issued monthly and payment is then required within two weeks. Unless prior notification is received, any late payment may incur an additional charge at KidZone's discretion. Payment can be made by cash, cheque or via the childcare voucher scheme.
